Times noted are CLOSE of registration. Fencing begins as soon after as possible. You should be at the venue no later than 30 minutes before close.

Event Fees and Deposits: Events are \$15 on line and \$40 for walk-ins + deposit Special events (e.g. Qualifiers, Round Robin, Pomme de Terre, etc.) have different fees.

NOTE: \$5 deposits may be collected from every fencer. They are returned after the fencer helps for one round after participation completed or when the manager is otherwise satisfied. **Only exact change in paper currency will be accepted.**

Please note that some events may be split between two clubs.

If traveling to a club for the first time, PLEASE leave early and allow yourself enough time to find the venue. Don't assume Mapquest, GPS, or website directions will be correct.

Competitive Attire and Gear: Fencers are responsible bringing their own gear and for knowing and following all USFA uniform and equipment rules. **DO NOT EXPECT HOST CLUBS TO OUTFIT YOU IF YOU DO NOT HAVE, OR FORGOT EQUIPMENT.**

DIVISION POLICY FOR USE OF CONDUCTIVE FOIL BIBS. The USFA policy states that, effective August 1st, 2012, the new bibs are to be used for all competitions; local as well as national and international. Until then, new bibs are only required at national/international events.

Fence! We want to encourage as many fencers as possible to compete. It is good for you; it is good for the division, especially for qualifiers. Usually, 25% of the fencers qualify. So even if you are an automatic, you are helping your fellow Division members by showing up.

Combining Events: When men's and women's events are to start at the same time or within 30 minutes of each other, the meets may be combined at the discretion of the meet managers if either event has less than six entries. Events "D" and higher will be mixed when less than 10 fencers of either gender have registered.

Low Turnout: Except for qualifiers, events with fewer than six entries will not be officially held. No entry fees

will be collected and no medals or ratings will be awarded.

Fencing Multiple Events: This will not be accommodated. A fencer not present at the start of pools and for each DE will be awarded a black card. If the fencer was present at the start of pools but fails to be on the strip when called, he will be issued a red card.
